*** Parent Governor Nominations – Reminder ***

The Robert Miles Junior School Local Governing Body (LGB) has **one vacancy for a parent governor**. We are looking for parents who have the skills required to contribute to effective governance and the success of the school.

Governing bodies are responsible for a wide range of matters which come under three main headings:

- Ensuring clarity of vision, ethos and strategic direction;
- Holding the headteacher to account for the educational performance of the school and its pupils, and the performance management of staff; and
- Overseeing monitoring of school processes and reporting performance to the Trust Board.

Our parent governors serve a four year term of office (even if your child leaves the school during this time), though governors may resign at any time. We usually meet 6 times per year as a local governing body on a Monday evening. There is an expectation that each governor will take on additional responsibilities as a link governor, which would include a visit to school once a year during the school day. **Parents/carers from minority groups, are usually under-represented on governing bodies and we would encourage nominations from parents with these characteristics.**

If you wish to complete a nomination form to become a parent governor, you need to:

- Complete the nomination form using this link: <u>https://forms.office.com/e/pXFMcFE85c</u>
- Include a statement, **up to 80 words**, about yourself, the skills and commitment you can bring to the governing body and why you would like to become a governor. You do not have to complete this section, but if you don't you may put yourself at a disadvantage if there is an election. All words over 80 will be deleted and not used in the election process.

The closing date for nominations is 10.00 am on **Monday 15 May 2023.** If you have any questions, please speak to Mr Evelyn who will be happy to answer them and discuss the role.
