| English | Our English lessons will be based around Poppy Waldo and the Giant which is continuing our Talk for Writing English scheme that the school started last year. We will be exploring character and dialogue. After half term we will be starting non-fiction work on information texts. |
| Maths | This half term we will be focusing on place value; we will be learning how to order and compare larger numbers, round numbers and we will find out about negative numbers and the Roman Numeral system. We will then move on to addition and subtraction calculations, followed by some work on multiplication and division. |
| History | In history, we are covering the earliest history of Britain, charting the changes from the Stone Age to the Iron Age and looking at how we can understand history without any written evidence through places and artefacts. |
| Science | Our topic is electricity; the children will have lots of practical work and chances to apply their knowledge to a design project in order to build a good understanding of circuits. We will also cover the safety issues associated with electricity. |
| Computing | Our computing sessions will cover programming in scratch and data handling. |
| Art/DT | DT will be linked to our electricity topic, with the children designing and making a light device. We will be learning about cave art in art and the development of painting linked to our history topic. |
| PSHE | Our PSHE topics this term are Being Me in My World and Celebrating Differences. These themes are explored in the classroom and through whole school assemblies. |
| RE | In Autumn term we are learning about Miraculous Escapes—a Jewish and Christian unit. |
| French/Music | French will be taught by Mrs Broster and music by Mrs Brown every Friday. |
