Homework	Reading: 10-15 minutes every day—please log this in your child's reading diary Spellings: weekly practice and test in school on Friday. Homework: A piece of homework will be handed out every Friday. Homework is to be handed in by the following Wednesday. Times tables: Regular times tables practice on TTRS . There will be weekly tests in school.
Home School Diary	Your child has a brand-new Home School Diary. Please help your child look after this and remember to bring it to school every day along with their reading book. Please write in their diary when they have read at home.
PE	Please ensure that your child has the correct PE uniform on their PE days. 4J Fridays with Mr Maylard-Mason 4H Fridays with Mr Maylard-Mason Please ensure your child has their PE kit in school every day just in case there is a timetable change. As this term may be wet or cold weather, please make sure PE kits have spare socks, suitable trainers and long jogging bottoms.
English	Our English lessons will be based around Poppy Waldo and the Giant which is continuing our Talk for Writing English scheme that the school started last year. We will be exploring character and dialogue. After half term we will be starting non-fiction work on information texts.
Maths	This half term we will be focusing on place value; we will be learning how to order and compare larger numbers, round numbers and we will find out about negative numbers and the Roman Numeral system. We will then move on to addition and subtraction calculations, followed by some work on multiplication and division.
History	In history, we are covering the earliest history of Britain, charting the changes from the Stone Age to the Iron Age and looking at how we can understand history without any written evidence through places and artefacts.
Science	Our topic is electricity; the children will have lots of practical work and chances to apply their knowledge to a design project in order to build a good understanding of circuits. We will also cover the safety issues associated with electricity.
Computing	Our computing sessions will cover programming in scratch and data handling.
Art/DT	DT will be linked to our electricity topic, with the children designing and making a light device. We will be learning about cave art in art and the development of painting linked to our history topic.
PSHE	Our PSHE topics this term are Being Me in My World and Celebrating Differences. These themes are explored in the classroom and through whole school assemblies.
RE	In Autumn term we are learning about Jewish life and family celebrations
French/Music	French will be taught by Mrs Broster and music by Mrs Brown every Friday.
